The School

The Falcons School for Boys (Preparatory) is an independent school for boys aged 7 – 13 based in Richmond. FSB has strong links with the Falcons School for Boys (Pre-Prep) in Chiswick and movement from the Pre-Prep to the Prep is automatic subject to an internal English and Mathematics assessment. Boys also join FSB from other pre-prep feeder schools and admission is subject to satisfactory performance in the tests and interviews.

The school, formerly called Falkner House, was founded in 1956 and was originally located in Notting Hill. The school transferred to the pre prep site in Burnaby Gardens, Chiswick in 1989 and changed its name to The Falcons. There are now three Falcons Schools: the Pre-Prep (1989), the Preparatory School for Boys (opened in Richmond in 2008) and The Falcons School for Girls (opened in Putney in 2011).

The Falcons School for Boys is a vibrant, happy school where the children are valued as individuals. The boys are challenged academically in class, out on the sports field and, artistically, on stage. Music and art are strong and the boys are also encouraged to take leadership responsibility from a young age.

Falcons School for Boys fosters intellectual curiosity by offering a curriculum that will stretch and challenge the most able boy whilst appealing to the majority with breadth and balance. At the Falcons there is a strong emphasis on how the boys conduct themselves and support one another. Core values of the school include trust, honesty and respect.
