

Job Description - Rugby Coach

Core Purpose : - To enhance the tight knit team of teaching/coaching staff and make a major contribution to the Stonyhurst Rugby Programme.

Reporting to : - The Director of Sport at Stonyhurst College

Key Responsibilities

The post holder must:

- Be extremely enthusiastic and highly committed with experience of coaching rugby in a school and/or club environment.
- The post demands a well organised individual with a clear vision for encouraging excellence across the range of playing experience, as well as a genuine interest in the all-round development of games players.
- Be able to contribute to other major sports depending on the successful applicant's skills and experience.
- Possess the organisational skill and attention to detail which will develop each pupil's sporting talent to the maximum, while ensuring that sport is seen as part of the wider curriculum
- To be committed to excellence in player preparation and performance
- To ensure a growing love of the game for all players

Key Responsibilities - Pastoral

- To be fully committed to the development of the whole person and recognise sport and rugby as a vehicle for personal growth, at an individual and collective level
- To follow key policies and established Stonyhurst guidelines in relation to pastoral care, pupil wellbeing and behaviour management

Generic Responsibilities

- To be mindful at all times of issues relating to Safeguarding and Health and Safety
- To comply with policies and procedures relating to child protection, health & safety, security, confidentiality and data protection, reporting all concerns to an appropriate person
- To contribute, as appropriate, to the wider life of the Stonyhurst St. Mary's Hall community
- To regularly reflect upon and evaluate professional performance
