Welcome

Thank you for considering the Aspirations Academies Trust for your next appointment.

We seek an excellent Director of Mathematics for our South Coast Region cluster of academies. (September 2018 start).

This newly created position has arisen due to the continued growth of the South Coast Region cluster of academies in the Aspirations MAT and Magna Academy Poole being designated as a NCTL National Teaching School and National Support School.

This position is a very rare and exciting opportunity to drive the strategic development of the 3-19 Mathematics curriculum and provision across a growing cluster of primary and secondary academies in Bournemouth, Poole and Dorset. We wish to create a hub of excellent Maths provision. The candidate would also lead Mathematics ITT, CPD and School to School Support work as part of our National Teaching School and Support School responsibilities.

The AAT South Coast Region currently comprises of the following academies (with likely further expansion):

- Magna Academy Poole (11-19)
- Atlantic Academy Portland (3-16)
- Ocean Academy Poole (7-11)
- Jewell Academy Bournemouth (R-11)
- Livingstone Academy Bournemouth (3-19) opening in September 2019
- Magna Academy Poole also is the home of Aspirations Teaching School Alliance

Key Purpose of the role:

- To develop the 3-19 Mathematics strategy, curriculum and pedagogy across the South Coast Region Academies, working alongside the Academies on the effective delivery of the Mathematics curriculum
- To monitor and support the overall progress and achievement of students in Mathematics across Atlantic Academy, Magna Academy, Ocean Academy and Jewell Academy (and other AAT South Coast Region academies as the Region grows e.g. Livingstone Academy)
- To develop, lead and support the strategic development of Mathematics across the AAT Academies in the South Coast Region
- To lead on supporting the **continuous improvement of the Mathematics curriculum** across the South Coast Region
- To lead on supporting the continuous improvement of Mathematics teaching across the South

The successful candidate will have very successful experience of raising attainment and progress in Maths at secondary level, as a middle leader and/or senior leader. The candidate should also have a good understanding of the new primary Mathematics curriculum and SATs.

Magna Academy is a **newly designated NCTL National Teaching School and National Support School.** Magna Academy is the lead National Teaching School for the Aspirations Academies Trust. The Academy co-ordinates School to School Support for other schools, including support for Atlantic Academy Portland, through deployment of Specialist Leaders of Education and a National Leader of Education

The Maths department is a growing, strong and dynamic team currently consisting of 8 teachers and 2 1:1/small group Maths tutors. The department consists of an established, highly skilled and experienced team, including a Vie- Principal, Assistant Principal, a Subject Co-ordinator, Deputy Subject Co-ordinator and a Maths Development Co-ordinator.

They are housed in a state of the art Maths area with a mix of classrooms, applied learning spaces, 1:1/small group Maths tutor rooms and the capacity to adapt to different learning strategies. All rooms are equipped with SMART boards. KS3 Maths homework is streamlined and centralised. Students complete 30 minutes of online 'Hegarty Maths' every evening. This is checked centrally and same day detentions issued for non-completion.

Maths A Level is currently offered in Year 12 and 13, and is popular.

Atlantic Academy Portland

Atlantic Academy Portland is an all through academy with Reception to Year 11 (post 16 from 2018).

It is located in stunning buildings, having benefitted from a £20 million plus full renovation program. It is situated on the beautiful **Isle of Portland**, at the heart of the Jurassic Coast, in **Dorset**, within easy reach of Weymouth, Dorchester, Yeovil, Poole and Bournemouth. This really is an academy at the very heart of the community.

There is also the potential for onsite accommodation be made available at a subsidised rate.

Atlantic Academy Portland offers you a unique opportunity to work in a Reception to Year 11 school where the schemes of learning are planned from Key Stage 1-4.

Primary Academies: Jewell Academy and Ocean Academy

Jewell Academy Bournemouth is a primary academy with Reception to Year 5 (Year 6 from 2018).

Jewell Academy Bournemouth is a primary academy in north Bournemouth which opened in September 2013 with just Reception and Year 1 pupils, and has grown year on year. It currently has pupils up to Year 5 and will be at full capacity in 2018 when those pupils reach Year 6. It was judged outstanding in all areas by Ofsted in June 2015.

Ocean Academy Poole is a junior academy with Year 3 to Year 5 (Year 6 from 2018). Ocean Academy Poole is a new junior academy which opened in September 2015 close to the centre of Poole. It has gained an excellent reputation locally and is already oversubscribed. It currently has Year 3, 4 and 5 pupils and from 2018 will be at full capacity when those pupils reach Year 6.
