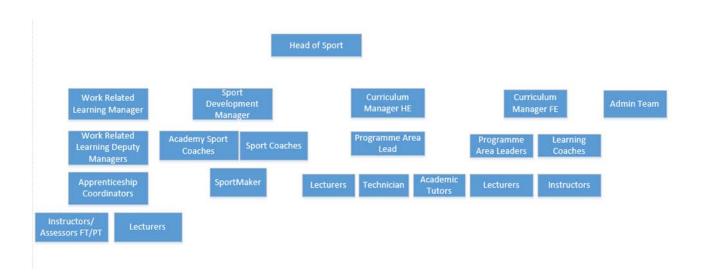
2. Job Purpose
