A. CURRICULUM

- 5. Have a wide range of teaching and learning styles which match the learning styles of your pupils
- 6. Demonstrate an understanding of issues to be considered in monitoring/evaluating children's performance in order to raise standards.
- 7. Be able to use ICT creatively and effectively
- 8. Be able to plan and deliver challenging lessons, which develop key skills including creative thinking
- 9. Be able to promote the school's Discipline Policy.
- 10. Have an understanding of an integrated challenge curriculum and how to teach pupils how to learn to learn.

B. PERSONAL QUALITIES

- 1. Approachable/accessible to other staff, pupils, parents and Governors.
- 2. Be inspirational, confident, enthusiastic, flexible, creative and reflective.
- 3. Strong interpersonal skills including the capacity to be persuasive, diplomatic, sensitive and resourceful.
- 4. Ability to think on their feet and solve problems with a 'can do' attitude
- 5. Commitment to the pastoral welfare of children combined with an understanding of social needs.
- 6. Ability to build positive and constructive relationships between school and the wider community.
