# French Teacher Job Description

#### **MAIN PURPOSE**

To contribute to the development of a strong, effective school with an emphasis on promoting a culture of educational excellence, within a caring and secure Islamic environment enriched with the values of discipline, mutual care and respect which extends beyond the school into the wider community.

#### 1. Strategic direction and development of the school

- 1.1 Provide inspiring & purposeful leadership for the students within a caring and secure Islamic environment.
- 1.2 Work in partnership with the Executive and Associate Principals, Senior Leadership Team, Governing Body, staff, students, parents and the Local Authority in generating the ethos and values which underpin the school enriched by mutual care and respect extending into the local community.
- 1.3 Promote and deliver the priorities and policies of the school by contributing to School Improvement and Development Planning, by consistently and persistently implementing agreed policies and initiatives and adhering to the school's ethos within and beyond the school.
- 1.4 Liaise as required with a range of educational partners to underpin the raising of student attainment.
- 1.5 Support the school's home and community liaison work through the appropriate participation in events.

#### 2. Learning, Teaching & Attainment

- 2.1 Support the Director of Learning for the faculty, through effective management of attainment at all stages.
- 2.2 Create and maintain an environment and a code of behaviour that promotes and secures good teaching, effective learning and high standards of achievement.
- 2.3 Develop, use and apply their subject expertise to secure appropriate and consistent progress for all students across the range of background and ability.
- 2.4 Plan lessons in which students of all abilities are supported and challenged to make outstanding progress.
- 2.5 Mark classwork and formal assessments regularly to provide timely and accurate feedback to learners and inform future lessons and intervention provision.
- 2.6 Deliver after-school intervention and enrichment to ensure the highest levels of achievement and enjoyment.
- 2.7 Develop and apply a range of effective learning and teaching strategies to raise the achievement of students, maintaining an up to date knowledge of good practice in Learning and Teaching techniques.
- 2.8 Observe and be observed by colleagues and utilise feedback effectively.
- 2.9 Participate in pedagogic discussion and development, in order to share effective practice with colleagues.
- 2.10 Use performance data to inform planning and teaching, including the evaluation of students' progress and setting of appropriate targets for improvement.
- 2.11 Make effective use of links with the community including business and industry, to extend the curriculum and enhance learning and teaching.
- 2.12 Create and maintain an effective partnership with parents to support and improve student and community achievement and personal development.
- 2.13 Ensure subject policies, schemes of work & lesson planning are regularly reviewed in light of best practice.
- 2.14 Participate in the development of enrichment across the school (including for G & T students) in partnership with other schools and agencies.

#### 3. Relationships with Others

- 3.1 Participate in the Performance Management Cycle and INSETs.
- 3.2 Participate in the induction of new staff into the school community.
- 3.3 Maintain good working relationships with colleagues, students, parents/carers, governors, the community and Local Authority and ensure all communication is consistent with the school's ethos.

#### 4. Accountability

- 4.1 Make best use of all resources to support the attainment of students.
- 4.2 Ensure that parents/carers and students are well informed about the curriculum, attainment and progress and about the contribution they can make in supporting their child's learning.
- 4.3 Carry out any such duties as may be reasonably required by the Executive and/or Associate Principals.
