The successful candidate will be sufficiently qualified that they can legally be employed by St. Lawrence College as a full-time teacher. Teaching Experience

The successful candidate will likely have experience of teaching EAL to children. Experience of a British educational system would also be preferred but is not essential for this position.

The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate a proven record of professional reliability, punctuality and excellent attendance record in previous employment. A native speaker of English is preferred and the successful applicant will also have very strong English communication skills – both written and oral. The successful candidate will be able to work closely with colleagues and will be able to show initiative and enthusiasm in their teaching. The successful candidate will possess an awareness of and a positive attitude towards British educational values and will also have an understanding of the importance of pastoral care, placing equal value on pupil wellbeing and development both in and out of the EAL classroom. The academic and pastoral values of the school will be promoted to maintain a happy, safe, and both academically and socially fulfilling environment for our pupils.
