We are a highly successful, community mixed comprehensive school with Teaching School status in a pleasant rural setting only 5 miles from the centre of Cambridge. We currently have around 1,800 11-18 pupils on roll including our new sixth form centre that opened in September 2011.

Our pupils are well motivated, staff morale is excellent and examination results are outstanding: 78% including Maths and English and 39% of grades were A*/A: whilst at A-level 90% of grades were A* - C.

We are seeking to appoint an outstanding teacher to join a large and dynamic PE department. The successful candidate would be expected to teach a broad curriculum across a range of key stages from KS3 to KS5. We currently offer examination courses in GCSE PE, GCSE Dance, BTEC Level 2 Sport, A-Level PE, BTEC National Extended Diploma and A-level dance. We are keen to appoint a teacher with experience of teaching some of these examination courses, and experience of teaching rugby and basketball would also be desirable. The department runs a very successful and thriving extra-curricular programme and the successful candidate would be expected to contribute fully to the after-school activities, including a range of fixtures against other local schools.

For the successful candidate there may be an opportunity to take on additional areas of responsibility within the department so the post would be suitable for both NQT's and experienced teachers.
