



English Faculty

The English Faculty at Ashby School is one of the larger faculties in the school with a skilled, energetic and vibrant team. There are currently 13 English teachers and a number of support staff. All English teachers have their own laptop and each English room is equipped with a projector and sound system.

In 2017, progress 8 analysis shows that the English department achieved a score of -0.02 and English language results saw 74% of students achieved a grade 4 or higher. Over the last three years' performance of pupil premium students has improved.

The English Faculty has a strong presence at Key Stage 5, offering both English Language and English Literature courses; every year well over a hundred students opt to study English at Key Stage 5.

As well as regular scheduled extra support offered to students, the faculty also offer a range of extra-curricular activities both in and out of school. These range from theatre trips to creative writing clubs. The faculty also offers extra support and intervention for those students not making expected progress.
