Thank you for your interest in the post of Learning Support Assistant at Maplewell Hall School. We are recruiting for a permanent member of staff to support our students across the school.

Maplewell Hall is a special school for students with moderate learning difficulties aged 11 – 19 years. At present there are 210 students on roll. The school is situated in extensive grounds in Charnwood Forest just outside Woodhouse Eaves and is six miles from Loughborough. Maplewell Autism Provision MAP 1 opened in September 2016 and MAP 2 opened from September 2017. MAP provides personalised learning for students with high functioning Autism and is designed to support students in reaching their full potential.

Working with our students at Maplewell is both challenging and rewarding. Our team of staff work together to develop students' confidence, academic and practical life skills, preparing them for life after school.

This permanent post is paid on Local Scale Grade 5, £17,007 – 17,392 pro rata, 32 hours per week, 39 weeks per year.

Maplewell Hall has a commitment to safeguard and promote the welfare of children and young people. We have robust processes and procedures to reduce risk and continuously promote a positive culture of safeguarding amongst our workforce.

The post you are applying for involves working with children and young people and you will be subject to Maplewell Hall's safer recruitment process.

This post is exempt from the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 and subject to an enhanced DBS Disclosure check.

The Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 aims to ensure that offenders who have not re-offended for a period of time since their conviction are not unfairly discriminated against when applying for jobs.
