Cheadle Hulme High School is the founder school for the Laurus Trust. We are a newly established Multi-Academy Trust with a vision for everyone regardless of background or circumstance to be inspired, to thrive in all environments, to recognise what it takes to succeed, to set aspirational goals and work hard to achieve them. In 2018 Laurus will open two brand new Free Schools in the local area, a two-form entry Primary School - Cheadle Hulme Primary School and a seven-form entry 11-16 Secondary School - Laurus Cheadle Hulme. Laurus has also been given the go ahead to open two further Secondary Schools, both 11-18 with a total of 1,300 students - in Manchester and Tameside.
