Educational Qualifications

The successful candidate will be sufficiently qualified that they can legally be employed by St. Lawrence College as a full-time teacher. The successful applicant will also have very strong English communication skills – both written and oral.

Teaching Experience

The successful candidate will likely have at least two years' experience of teaching ICT or Computer Science to children. Experience of a teaching in the British educational system would be a significant advantage, but is not essential for the position. A familiarity with at least 1 common programming language is essential, and experience of either Python or Visual Basic would be a benefit.

Personal Characteristics

The successful candidate will be able to demonstrate a proven record of professional reliability, punctuality and excellent attendance in his or her previous employment. A confident and extremely high standard of English is essential to ensure a competent level of communication both in and out of the classroom. The successful candidate will be able to work closely with colleagues to ensure that the delivery of the subject is effective and consistent. They will have a passion for Computer Science which will allow them to engage pupils and enable them to appreciate the importance of the subject. The successful candidate will also have an understanding of the importance of pastoral care, and place equal value on the importance of pupil wellbeing and development both in and out of the Computer Science classroom. The academic and pastoral values of the school will be promoted to maintain a happy, safe, and both academically and socially fulfilling environment for our pupils.
