Background

International School Brunei was established in 1964, as a non-profit organisation with a Board of Directors to oversee development of the school - a status that exists to this day.

In 2015 the school moved to a brand new 22 acre site on the outskirts of Bandar Seri Begawan, the capital of Brunei Darussalam. At the same time, 'The Residence' a state of the art Boarding House, was opened to cater for students aged 11 - 18. ISB also has a Primary School in Kuala Belait, Brunei. Our KB site is small and growing. Current plans are to move the school to a new site in 2019 to enable further growth and to meet the needs of the school's community.

The school offers Early Years Foundation are based on their needs, strengths and Stage Curriculum education from Pre-Kindy (2yrs) and an internationally adapted National Curriculum of England and Wales from Year 1 (4yrs old) to Year 9 (13yrs) followed by IGCSEs (15-16yrs) and the IB Diploma programme in the Pre-University section (16 -18yrs).

The school is non-selective, and currently has over 1200 students from over 42 different nationalities. Academic results are outstanding, with IGCSE and IB Diploma

results consistently above the world average. Students leave ISB to attend top universities all over the world.

The Position

The role of class teacher is to provide outstanding student outcomes through delivery of a creative curriculum. Working collaboratively with colleagues you will create learning opportunities for our students that previous experiences. You will be responsible for providing exceptional pastoral care and be able to prioritise the happiness and wellbeing of all students.
