In Year 7 & 8 students receive 7 lessons of Mathematics a fortnight. In Year 7 the classes are taught in 2 bands, with students being set on entry within these 2 bands. In Year 8 the students are set across the year. In Years 9-11 students receive 8 lessons a fortnight and are set across the year group. To meet the needs of our students we sit the AQA GCSE.

All teachers in the faculty have their own room and are provided with laptops. The maths classrooms all have interactive whiteboards as well as visualisers to support teaching and learning.
