The closing date is 12 noon on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> April 2018.

This vacancy arises as the current post holder, Mr Tim Beesley, has been appointed as the new Principal of All Hallows Catholic College in Macclesfield. This is an exciting time for someone to come and work with our experienced and effective Senior & Middle Leadership Teams and help to strengthen and improve the good work already being done.

It is a stimulating environment to work in, for both students and staff, and expectations and standards are high.
