The Science Department at Huntington School consists of a committed and enthusiastic staff of fourteen teachers, four technicians and a departmental assistant. We are very fortunate to have a well balanced team of Science specialists. The science teacher appointed will work within this team, helping to build on its reputation for rigour and innovation.

The Department is exceptionally well resourced with eleven laboratories, three of which have recently been refurbished, each with projection facilities. These are maintained by an outstanding team of technicians.

The School is seeking to appoint an enthusiastic, hardworking science teacher to make an important contribution to this successful Department.

The Curriculum

The Science Department is committed to delivering high quality teaching and learning to enable all students to achieve across all Key Stages. We are currently implementing our new schemes of learning for the new Key Stage 5 specifications and are in the third year of teaching our new KS3 curriculum. We are working collaboratively to develop schemes of learning which will continue to inspire students in Science in response to the national changes at KS4.

In the **Upper School**, we offer:

- AQA GCSE Separate Sciences (GCSE Biology, Chemistry and Physics)
- AQA GCSE Combined Science (Trilogy)
- AQA Entry Level Certificate (as appropriate depending on need)

In the **Sixth Form** the Science curriculum is equally broad, with the department offering:

- Biology GCE: AQA
- Chemistry GCE: AQA
- Physics GCE: EdExcel
- Applied Science GCE: AQA
