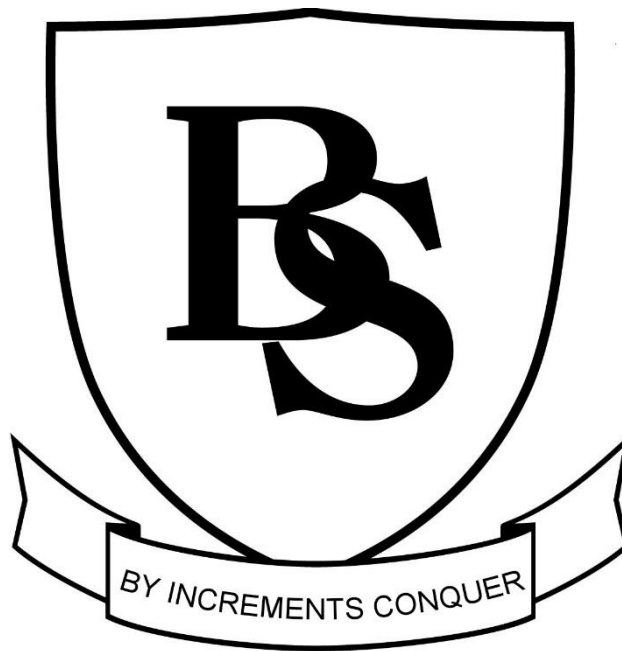

Mathematics Curriculum

Key Stage 3

There will be 7 x 60 minute lessons per two weeks allocated for Mathematics.

Key Stage 4

8 x 60 minute lessons per two weeks will be allocated. All pupils study for GCSE Mathematics and Certificates of Achievement when appropriate. .

Teaching Week

Broadwater has a 25 hour teaching week, operating 50 x 60 minute lessons, 5 lessons a day, 3 in the morning and 2 in the afternoon over 10 days.

Accommodation and Resources

The Mathematics Department is located in a suite of attractive rooms on the second floor of the Tower Block. The rooms are well appointed and there are good storage facilities and a small office. The Department is well resourced with each Maths room having an interactive whiteboard, subscription to Mathswatch and a bank of laptops available for use within the Maths department. All classrooms have a set of GCSE textbooks.

Management

Currently there are five teaching members of staff including the Head of Department. We are a hard-working, friendly and supportive team, committed to high levels of achievement.
