At Minsthorpe Community College, we take a flexible approach to our use of INSET time for teaching staff. We believe that, as professionals, teachers should take ownership of their own professional learning alongside their colleagues and within a clear framework of CPD. Staff may choose to watch the pre-recorded materials during the dedicated INSET time or at another more convenient point.

Identified areas of CPD could include:

- Delivering training to other staff;
- SCITT/NQT mentoring;
- Acting as a host teacher for SCITT trainees;
- Mentoring other staff;
- Disseminating information to colleagues from external CPD;
- Attending Wakefield Learning Community sessions;
- Partnership work with New Collaborative Teaching School Alliance, including SLE work;
- Completion of NPQML whole-college project;
- Subject Knowledge Enhancement;
- Structured Conversations;
- SEND;
- Lesson Study or Personal Enquiry.

L&T Pre-recorded materials will:

- Explore principles of high quality L&T as outlined in 'Making Every Lesson Count', Allison & Tharby e.g. Challenge & Modelling & 'Teaching Walkthrus', Sherrington & Caviglioli;
- Provide skills to effectively manage classroom behaviour promoting a positive climate for learning;
- Develop knowledge of Metacognition & Cognitive Load Theory, including Rosenshine's 'Principles of Instruction'

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- Continue to embed Literacy & Numeracy across the curriculum;
- Provide opportunities for collaboration and learning from others;
- Be flexible and responsive to meet the needs of staff at key points throughout the academic year.

1. Peer Coaching (TBC in light of Covid-19 pandemic):

All teaching staff will take part in peer coaching observations during ?? Staff will choose a coach and work with them through lesson planning, lesson observation & an 'open dialogue' approach to feedback. This is a developmental process designed to allow staff to focus on improving a specific area of their classroom practice.
