A LEVEL CURRICULUM

Studying for A Levels allows pupils to play to their strengths. We encourage pupils to choose subjects they enjoy and are good at; this innate enthusiasm for their chosen subjects is essential for the independent study required during the A Level courses.

Our Sixth Form pupils initially choose four subjects to study, from a range of 21 different options. They may continue with all four subjects through to the final examinations at the end of Year 13, or decide to drop down to three during Year 12.

What makes Brighton College's Sixth Form very unique is the one-to-one attention we get in lessons. The teachers truly know us, not just as pupils, but as people too.

PASTORAL CARE

Pupils join one of four Houses with access to a House Parent and Tutor who focus on the wellbeing and achievements of each and every pupil in their care. Our House-based system gives pupils the opportunity to develop leadership qualities as senior members of the school, whilst also enabling them to form firm friendships from their very first day.

We support pupils through the university application process with staff who are experts in delivering successful outcomes, as well as carefully tailored programmes for facing university entrance tests and interviews. We also encourage pupils to consider their full range of options, such as a 'gap' year between school and university or more vocational alternatives.

















BEYOND THE CLASSROOM

Our Sixth Form pupils are challenged far beyond the scope of the curriculum with a broad range of Extended Studies options. These include:

- Critical thinking and communication skills
- The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award
- Community Service
- International Olympiads

Sixth Form pupils also learn to 'Study Smart', helping them plan and manage their work independently. They practise debating and public speaking, and are challenged to develop their confidence, resilience and leadership skills.

THE CAMPUS AND FACILITIES

Our 50 rai campus contains some of the finest facilities of any international school in the world.

Our Performing Arts Centre contains drama and dance studios, instrumental teaching rooms and a 650-seat theatre to showcase our passion for performance.

Pupils can keep fit in our sports hall and fitness suite, as well as on an outdoor football pitch, four tennis courts, our 400m athletics track and in our 50m and 25m swimming pools.

Sixth Form pupils can also make themselves at home in their very own purpose-built Learning Resource Centre, with spaces for quiet study, informal meetings and relaxation.


