OUR TEACHERS

The quality of our teachers is one of the most important areas of concern for us. We hire experienced and fully qualified teachers from native-English speaking countries: 80% are from the UK, the rest are from America, Australia and New Zealand. They all possess passion, drive, superior knowledge and teaching expertise in their particular field.

Our teaching staff have UK accredited Qualified Teacher Status (QTS). We have rigorous selection procedures and a lower staff turnover than most international schools. All teachers come to us with a variety of personal achievements and interests that add greatly to the breadth and depth of our curriculum.

Being a teacher is more than a job. It is a calling. And our teachers' passion is reflected in how the parents see our school. In fact, a recent parents survey shows that almost 50% of our parents consider the high quality of our teachers to be our key success factor.









CURRICULUM OVERVIEW & LEARNING OBJECTIVES

Regent's International School, Bangkok and Langsuan Campus, one of Thailand's leading international schools, is a day and boarding school for 2 to 18 years old, passionate about developing the whole person through academic, physical, cultural and social experiences. We are guided by the British curriculum from the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) leading to IGCSEs. Post 16 we adopt the IB (International Baccalaureate) Diploma Programme.

Our approach guides students into becoming well-rounded, informed, responsible, principled and confident global citizens. We do this by developing international understanding, empathy and tolerance for all cultures, democratic governance and justice, environmental stewardship, adventure, motivating self-discovery and courage, leadership, with courage and compassion and service to others.





EARLY YEARS CURRICULUM

We believe creative learning is key to a child's healthy development and therefore place emphasis on teaching through active play. Children learn by playing and exploring, being active and through creative and critical thinking, both indoors and outside.

All teachers in Early Years are native English speakers and every class has an additional Teaching Assistant. We follow the English Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum (EYFS). Our learning community provides a strong start in education, to facilitate the transition into Primary School. We observe each child's progress and work hard to ensure that all children will have made language, literacy and personal development by the end of the Early Years Foundation Stage.

Regent's Early Years is divided into three age groups: Pre-Nursery, Nursery and Reception. The learning is designed around three prime areas: Communication and language, Physical development and personal, social and emotional development, as well as four specific skills areas: Literacy, Mathematics, Understanding the world, Expressive arts and design.





PRIMARY CURRICULUM

At Regent's we are passionate about ensuring each child gets the most out of their education as we strive to create a community of life-long learners. We recognise the importance of the Primary Years as the foundation of their education and believe their time of development and discovery should be inspiring and exciting.

The English National Curriculum is made up of the following academic Key Stages:
- Key Stage 1 (Years 1 - 2 for students aged 4-7 years old)

- Key Stage 2 (Years 3 - 6 for students aged 7-11 years old)
We divide the management of our school into Lower Primary Phase Year 1-3 and Upper Phase Year 4-6.







SECONDARY CURRICULUM

Regent's International School offers a holistic education that places every child at the heart of the curriculum. In order to realise this vision, we provide all students a broad, balanced range of academic subjects that is delivered by experienced international teachers. We also ensure that all students develop their literacy in English. This curriculum is supported by a strong pastoral team as well as a variety of enrichment and extracurricular activities. Our curriculum is based on Key Stages that build on the Primary School curriculum and ensure progression from year to year.







IB

The International Baccalaureate (IB) is a rigorous academic program emphasizing academic achievement, critical thinking, research skills and community service. It has been operating worldwide for almost 30 years and is in place in almost 1500 schools in around 120 countries around the world. The IB Diploma is recognized in virtually every country in the world.








Key roles and Responsibilities
