# ACADEMIC BERLIN INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL

### **PROFILE**

Founded in 1998, the Berlin International School (B.I.S.) is a private, not-for-profit, co-educational school of the Private Kant-Schulen Foundation that offers an international education. The languages of instruction are English and German. The school offers the Cambridge IGCSE programme in Grades 9 & 10, as well as the Berlin state examinations BBR and MSA. The IB Diploma Programme (IBDP) is facilitated in Grades 11 & 12, and a bilingual version of the German Abitur can be selected at Campus Steglitz, B.I.S.'s sister school.

### THE SCHOOL COMMUNITY

B.I.S. has a current enrollment of 820 students from almost 80 nations. High School enrollment: 247 • Graduating Seniors: 59

### **BERLIN INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL FACULTY**

B.I.S. Secondary (Grades 6-12) has 62 faculty members. Approximately one-third are German nationals. The remainder of our staff is comprised of experts from approximately 16 countries.

### **EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

Students can choose from sporting, cultural, service and personal enrichment activities that extend them beyond the classroom and help to broaden their range of interests. Among them are: Student Council, Model United Nations, Speech & Debate, School Newspaper and Magazine (on-line and print), and Documentary Film Club. School athletic teams compete in multiple competitions within the German International School Sports Tournament (GISST), an athletic conference. A range of local and international matches and competitions round out a dynamic sporting programme.

### **SCHOOL CALENDAR**

The B.I.S. school year consists of a minimum of 180 school days divided over two semesters that run from the end of August through January, and from February through the beginning of July.

### **INTERNATIONAL GENERAL CERTIFICATE OF SECONDARY EDUCATION (IGCSE)** from the University of Cambridge

The International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) in Grades 9 & 10 prepares students for the IGCSE examinations from the University of Cambridge. The Cambridge International Exams (CIE) are an international qualification that provide admission to higher educational institutions in Europe and many other parts of the world. Student performance on the IGCSE exams is a basis for acceptance and course selection in the IBDP in Grades 11 & 12.

### **MSA AND BBR**

The MSA (Mittlerer Schulabschluss) qualifies Berlin students for vocational training ('Berufsausbildung') and gives students access to the 'gymnasiale Oberstufe' (upper school, Grades 11-13). The BBR (Berufsbildungsreife) in Grades 9 or 10 and the eBBR (erweiterte Berufsbildungsreife) in Grade 10 qualify students for vocational training ('Berufsausbildung'). Both exams are externally set by the Berlin government.

#### **ACCREDITATION**

Berlin International School is fully accredited by the Council of International Schools (CIS) and the New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC) and is an IB World School.

B.I.S. is also a member of the Association of German International Schools (AGIS).

### THE IB DIPLOMA PROGRAMME AT THE B.I.S.

The heart of the university qualifying program at B.I.S is the IBDP, which takes place during the last two years (Grades 11 & 12) of Secondary. Over 38 IBDP courses are on offer this year. IBDP students take three Higher Level (HL) and three Standard Level (SL) subjects as well as complete the core aspects of the IBDP. These consist of a 4000 word Extended Essay (EE), 150 hours of Creativity/Activity/Service (CAS), and the Theory of Knowledge (TOK) course. The examinations, like IGCSE assessments, are externally set and marked. All students in Grades 11 and 12 are enrolled in the IBDP. In order to be awarded the IB Diploma, a student must earn at least 24 points. A student can also earn a 'Bilingual IB Diploma' by meeting one or both of two criteria: (a) the completion of two A languages selected from group 1; Studies in language and literature with a grade of 3 or higher in both; (b) or completion of one of the subjects from group 3, Individuals and societies or group 4, Experimental sciences in a language that is not the same as the candidate's nominated group 1 A language, with a grade of 3 or higher.

IBDP grades are on a 1 to 7 scale, with four (4) being passing and seven (7) outstanding. The maximum amount of points available is 45. This includes the possibility of three (3) points for the EE and TOK. HL courses are given extra weight for the grade point average. Students obtaining the IB diploma also receive an American High School diploma.
