IT Manager with enthusiasm, a passion for IT and excellent organisational and communication skills is required for Kingsley School in North Devon.

Previous experience of working in an IT Management position is essential for this role.

As the IT Manager your key day to day responsibilities will include trouble shooting, monitoring and maintaining the school's IT infrastructure, and responding quickly in an appropriate manner to all requests for IT assistance or support. You will be in sole charge of the IT support desk so it's important that you are confident in dealing with the above. Alongside this you will be responsible for coordinating, planning, and leading computer-related activities at Kingsley School. Determining the IT needs and implementing computer systems to fulfil the schools information systems requirements.

The school has a Microsoft based IT environment making full use of cloud-based infrastructure including the Office 365 suite. The department supports a mixture of servers, workstations, laptops, tablets, printers and interactive whiteboards.
