Knowledge and understanding	The class teacher will have knowledge and understanding of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the theory and practice of providing effectively for the individual needs of all children (eg. classroom organisation and learning strategies); - statutory National Curriculum requirements at the appropriate age phase; - the monitoring, assessment, recording and reporting of pupils' progress; - how to organise classrooms, corridors and learning resources to create a positive and engaging learning environment; - effective teaching and learning styles. 	In addition, the class teacher may also have knowledge and understanding of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - the preparation and assessment of statutory National Curriculum tests; - an understanding of the challenges faced by EAL learners.
Skills	The class teacher will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - promote the aims of the school positively and use effective strategies to monitor motivation and morale; - develop good personal relationships within a team; - establish and develop close relationships with parents and the directors of the school; - communicate effectively (both orally and in writing) to a variety of audiences; - create a happy, challenging and effective learning environment; - demonstrate the personal qualities needed to live and work in Spain.
