Ellesmere College is an all age special school that offers educational provision for students from 4-19 with complex learning needs. We have expertise in working with students with a wide range of learning difficulties including Autistic Spectrum disorder (ASD), Asperger syndrome, attachment difficulties, communication and interaction difficulties, hearing impairment, visual impairment and cognition and learning needs.

We provide specialist provision for learners with varied and complex needs who have below average ability and are unable to successfully access a mainstream school setting. Working as an efficient and effective multidisciplinary team, we aim to make our college a happy place where expectations are high and individuals are valued. We aim to achieve a standard of excellence appropriate to each individual, enriching, encouraging and equipping each child for their future lives.

Our facilities include a sensory room, two soft plays, a BMX track, cycle track, access to 4G pitch and horticultural area.
