

Principal's Welcome

Glenmoor & Winton Academies motto is 'High Achievement, High Standards'. We believe that every child matters and every lesson counts, creating well rounded citizens achieving academic excellence. Glenmoor & Winton is a highly inclusive school that caters for the needs of all students. We ensure our most able students are stretched academically and students with special educational needs and disabilities are expertly supported, allowing the Academies to ensure the best in everyone.

Our results in 2016 were outstanding, with Glenmoor students achieving 73% A* - C in English and maths and Winton students achieving 82%. The results placed Glenmoor and Winton Academies as the highest performing secondary comprehensive in Bournemouth, Poole and Christchurch, and top of the United Learning group, a chain which spans the entire country and includes over 35 other academies.

Glenmoor & Winton are unique through the decision taken in September 2013 to co-locate the two Academies but remain separate schools through lessons being taught in a single sex environment. This has proved hugely successful with resources, staffing expertise and curriculum opportunities now being fully utilised for the benefit of all students at the Academies. Co-location has been seen by all stakeholders as offering the 'best of both' which I believe provides our students with the best possible chance of educational success.

The outcome of our last Ofsted inspection in June 2015, graded Glenmoor and Winton Academies as good in all areas. This is a huge achievement for everyone associated with Glenmoor and Winton as the rigour, standards and expectations placed upon schools by Ofsted through its inspection process continues to rise.

Quotes in the reports include: 'Students behave exceptionally well around the site. The Academy is a calm and safe environment for learning'; 'Students achieve well across the curriculum, and exceptionally well in English'; 'Learning is characterised by exceptionally good relationships between staff and students'.

What both inspection reports highlight is the high quality learning experience all students currently receive at the Academies and the commitment and dedication of all staff to continue to develop this philosophy of an outstanding learning experience for all students.
