


Lincoln Minster Preparatory School Music Department

Music plays a prominent part in the life of Lincoln Minster School, being at the forefront of the musical and cultural life of the school.

Class music is part of the normal curriculum and is taught by specialists from Early Years up to Year 6. Instrumental tuition is offered and taught individually by visiting teachers. Strong emphasis is placed on participation in the many musical activities of the school, which includes Prep Orchestra, Choir, Concert Band and Strings Orchestra. Prep Orchestra is timetabled, with the others offered as extra-curricular activities at lunchtime and after school.

The school presents termly concerts each year, at which pupils perform solo and small group items and the full orchestra. A musical is staged biennially with "A Night at the Musicals" and "Mr Benn" being the most recent productions. At the Pre-Prep, annual Nativity's are staged, along with a spring concert and a summer show.

Assemblies are an important part of the school week and pupils are given the opportunity to share their talents with the school community, led and overseen by the Head of Prep Music. Our pupils are also involved in providing music for our Annual Prize Giving service and end of term services, both of which take place in Lincoln Cathedral.
