- Participate in arrangements for preparing pupils learning and achievement in line with the school policy.
- Attend and take a constructive part in staff meetings, inset days and any other school inset sessions.
- Contribute towards school assemblies.
- Set a high standard of punctuality.
- To take responsibility to effectively manage a classroom to maximise learning.
