The School

Giffnock Primary School was established in the early 1900s in the local church hall, the school moved to the present building 5 years later in 1905/06. An extension to the original building was completed a few years ago, bringing the facilities and classrooms up to date.

Location

Giffnock Primary School is situated in the suburban area of Giffnock in East Renfrewshire. The catchment area consists mainly of privately owned housing.

The school also has 7 Pupil Support Assistants, 1 Senior Child Development Officer, 1 Child Development Officer, 1 Bilingual support Worker (0.6 FTE), 3 clerical staff, 4 visiting musical specialists (violin, guitar, brass, woodwind), 6 catering staff, 3 cleaning staff and 1 janitors.

Community

The school has an active Parent Council. Parents are welcome and encouraged to become involved in the life of the school. Links with other agencies, schools and the community in general are welcomed and encouraged. The school offers a variety of after school activities for all children.

The Building

The Giffnock building is in good condition and provides good-sized classrooms. The building consists of 4 areas, the main / administration block, back wing, lower wing and tower block.

Main / Administration block: Head Teacher's office, general office, library, computer suite, primary classes, school hall, resource room, senior management room, storage space, pupil toilets, staff room, toilets, entrance to gym hall & kitchen and staff room.

Lower Wing: Nursery, entrance to Tower Block, medical room, support staff base, pupil toilets and janitor's room.

Back Wing: Primary classes and pupil toilets. Tower Block: primary classes.
