Teaching and Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Teach challenging, well-organised lessons and sequences of lessons across the age and ability range in KS3, 4 and IB • Responsible for classroom display and teaching materials • Set homework according to the timetable and marking it accurately and promptly • Maintain accurate data records in the school systems • Assess students in line with department policy • Complete reports and writing special reports on specific pupils when required.
Professional Knowledge and Understanding	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Good, up-to-date working knowledge and understanding of a range of teaching and learning strategies and know how to use and adapt them, including how to personalise learning to provide opportunities for all learners to achieve their potential • Engage in CPD and have ownership in developing own practice • Share good practice in department meetings.
Personal Responsibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take responsibility for safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children • Uphold positive values and attitudes, adopting high standards of behaviour in your professional role • Attend parent/teacher meetings and attend any special after school meetings when required (e.g. staff meetings, departmental, subject, year group meetings) • Use non-contact periods for discussions/meetings • Undertake other duties appropriate to the post that may reasonably be required from time to time.
