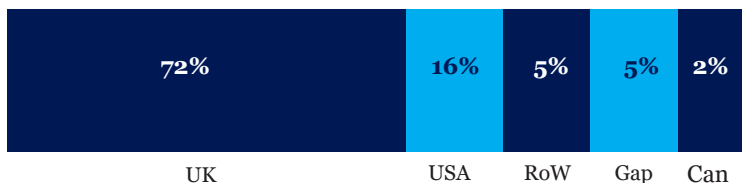

Dubai College is an inclusive school and we welcome applications from young people with SEND. We have students on roll with Dyslexia, Dysgraphia, Dyspraxia, ASD, physical disabilities, hearing, visual and sensory impairments and BESD. The school is committed to student and staff wellbeing and has two full time counsellors. In 2017-18 21 students with SEND took a range of external examinations with a 100% pass rate at A*- B at KS4 with all Y13 young people with SEND gaining university places.
