THE SCHOOL

Founded in partnership with Paragon Partners, North London Collegiate School Bangkok (NLCS Bangkok), will offer an academically ambitious education in keeping with the aspirational ethos of NLCS (UK). The school will provide the same impressive range of extra-curricular activities for which North London Collegiate School (UK), NLCS Jeju (South Korea) and NLCS Dubai, are well known, to foster well-rounded individuals who are capable of becoming leaders.

This selective girls' day school for students aged 5-18 years, will be built and funded by NLCS International's partners, Paragon Partners. The school will be purpose built, boasting impressive, state-of-the-art facilities.

The school aims are:

- To provide an ambitious academic education to enable every individual student to make the most of her intellect and abilities
- To nurture a team of professional teachers who inspire their students with a love of their subjects and a spirit of scholarship
- To enable all students to recognise excellence and realise that it is attainable

- To foster a community built on positive relationships between staff and students and between students themselves
- To encourage students to embrace new challenges confidently, and respond to setbacks in a resilient and determined manner

THE CURRICULUM

The school will follow the British curriculum up to age 16, developing to International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme in the sixth form.

THE POSITION

NLCS Bangkok is looking for a dynamic, well qualified and committed Head of Science with an outstanding track record of examination success to lead teaching and learning within the Science Faculty from 15th July 2019.

The appointee will be responsible for the educational leadership of science at NLCS Bangkok. He/she will lead a team of specialist teachers who will deliver lessons in Physics, Chemistry and Biology throughout the Senior School (and from Year 5 in the Junior School). It is essential that the Head of Science has the ability to communicate enthusiasm and passion for the subject areas.

Previous experience of the IB Diploma may be an advantage. Of prime importance is an ability to motivate and inspire students and lead staff in order to ensure that academic provision is consistently of the highest



standard. Applications are invited from either Physics, Chemistry or Biology specialists, although the ability to teach more than one science subject would be advantageous.

The Head of Science will also lead one of the three science departments, and will work with the other two Heads of Department within the faculty to manage all aspects of teaching, learning and curriculum planning, in keeping with the overall aims of the school. He / she will also be responsible for supporting members of the faculty in all appropriate ways, ensuring that they work together as a cohesive and collegiate team in order to effectively deliver the aims and priorities of the school.

The appointee will ensure that all members of the faculty offer support to the learning and pastoral needs of individual students, in keeping with the school's pastoral policy and the school's aims and values. All members of staff are also expected to be involved in pastoral care within the school community, usually in the role of form tutor or co-tutor. All members of staff are also to contribute to the extra-curricular life of the school, and the Head of Science will ensure that extracurricular provision across the sciences is rich and vibrant, with a clear academic focus. The Head of Science will ensure that there is appropriate enrichment to enhance the science curriculum, and in particular that there is effective support for students who are considering making aspirational university applications in subjects relating to the sciences.
