About The Group

Evolution Knowledge Investments (EKI) provides outstanding British curriculum education in UAE and Oman. EKI's school portfolio comprises Repton Dubai, Foremarke Dubai and Repton Abu Dhabi in UAE alongside Dovecote and Humpty Dumpty nurseries with branches across UAE and Oman. Our schools and nurseries boast world-class facilities and a commitment to hiring and developing the best academic talent to support the development of the whole child and prepare them for the challenges of higher education and the exciting yet complex world beyond.

Our History & Pedigree

In 2006, EKI partnered with Repton School, a prestigious Derbyshire-based independent school in England with a history of more than 450 years of education excellence, to offer a British independent school education in the GCC region.

The first school arising from this partnership, Repton School Dubai opened in 2007. Until 2013 Repton School's overseas interests had been managed directly by the UK school. However with the opening of Foremarke Dubai and Repton Abu Dhabi in 2013 Repton International Schools Ltd (RISL) was established to manage Repton's overseas interests.

RISL has direct representation on the Boards of Governors of all EKI schools, thereby ensuring a close and coherent relationship with the strategic direction of the schools. The Quality Assurance framework developed by Repton School has created the foundations for the national education inspections. Repton Dubai has for some years been rated as Outstanding, with Foremarke Dubai and Repton Abu Dhabi both rated as Very Good with many outstanding features.

EKI's objective is to have all portfolio schools rated as Outstanding and to be recognised leaders in the field of education technology.

In support of this, whilst our schools each have unique features and personalities, we believe we're stronger when we work as a group therefore all teams across our UAE schools work closely together to share best practice, incubate innovation and participate in shared CPD activities.

Repton School Dubai – Overview

Repton Dubai is a prominent international school in the heart of Dubai, which has recently celebrated its tenth birthday. One of the few genuinely international schools in the Gulf Region, Repton Dubai combines the reputation and academic rigour of the UK curriculum, from infants and junior school up to IGCSE level in Year 11, and then embraces the challenges and opportunities of the



International Diploma or IB in the Sixth Form. Set in a stunning campus in Nad Al Sheba, and almost uniquely in Dubai, also offering a dynamic boarding experience, Repton pupils from ages 3-18 benefit from facilities, resources and a classroom and sporting experience, that is the envy of their peers.

Our Teachers

All that we achieve at Repton is dependent on recruiting outstanding teachers, and then ensuring that continuous professional development (CPD) is embedded within the culture of the school. Repton recruits the majority of teachers from the UK and works very hard to provide ongoing support and further training.

All Repton teachers are highly-trained professionals who care to further their own learning. The Headmaster regularly poses 'What are you reading?' and the culture of erudition within this outstanding school is perceptible. Repton teachers are skilled within their own subject discipline; students in Year 3 and Year 4 enjoy some specific, specialist-lead classes and those in Year 5+ benefit from specialist teaching across all disciplines. By the time that the rigorous International Baccalaureate is reached in Year 12 and Year 13, teachers are skilled in exploring the necessary demands at the highest level of their subjects.



A forward-thinking CPD programme enables staff not only to work upon the specific needs of their subject, but also to reflect and plan for the betterment of their own mindset and approach. An in-house Middle Leaders Programme, SPARK events and CPD pathways, create the autonomy that teachers need, in order to thrive. Parents can be safe in the knowledge that Repton teachers role model the most positive learning behaviours, including life-long learners.

All members of our community strive to show Respect, to be Extraordinary, to be Principled, to be Thinkers, to be Open-minded

and to be Nurturing. Every day, Repton teachers aim to live out and exemplify these values alongside their teaching.

The staff group "Reptonic" work together to focus upon all aspects of Well-being, Welfare and Social gatherings for the staff of Repton. Staff sports, pot luck lunches, meditation sessions and buddy systems are examples of events that are promoted by this team.

Our Curriculum

Our pupils follow an academic programme based on the British National Curriculum from Early Years to Year 11, (FS1 to Grade 10) studying a broad range of International GCSEs, examined at age 16 in Year 11, accredited by the Cambridge and London University Exam Boards.

Thereafter students study for the International Baccalaureate qualification, post 16, following either the Diploma or Careers programmes. The latter qualification is available through a BTEC qualification for both Business and Physical Education. At the senior school, the academic programme is organised into three terms. In Years 7-9 (Grades 6-8), pupils are taught core subjects (Maths, English, Science) in ability groups and non-core subjects in mixed ability groups.

At the end of Year 9 (Grade 8), students choose their IGCSE options and follow these over a two year period. At the end of Year 11, pupils are awarded their IGCSE certificates and those achieving a minimum of 6 passes at grade 6 are invited to join the sixth form to follow the IB Diploma or Careers Programme. For students opting to follow the IB Careers pathway a minimum of 6 passes at grade 4 or better are required.

The International Baccalaureate is intellectually rigorous, demanding that pupils not only attain high academic standards but also that students fully participate in out of class activities through the Creativity Action Service (CAS) aspect of the Diploma. In addition, students study a course in the Theory of Knowledge [TOK] and complete a 4000 word Extended Essay. Through these courses pupils develop the knowledge of how to learn and positively challenge their perspectives of the world from a variety of differing viewpoints.

A World-Class Campus

Repton Dubai boasts the largest, most spectacular school campus in the Middle-East, including extensive boarding facilities, sports fields, swimming pools and specialist labs, music facilities and much more.



Pastoral Care

At Repton, fostering the well-being of our pupils through a patient, positive and proactive pastoral care system is at the very heart of our ethos. Our experienced staff recognise how nurturing individual personal development and promoting happiness and well-being can enable students to thrive both academically and emotionally. We are immensely proud that our pastoral care has been routinely celebrated as 'Outstanding' by the KHDA over the past four years.

Through Heads of Year, students are offered personalised academic guidance alongside a bespoke PSHCE programme to meet their individual needs. We also have a hugely successful House system that fosters the spirit of competition and community, creating numerous pupil and student leadership opportunities as well as collaboration between older and younger pupils.

We take great care to provide individual attention and to encourage our pupils to challenge themselves, to live by our shared values and to strive to be the very best person that they can be. Character and moral education is integral to our vision of the highest quality pastoral care and it is our genuine privilege to work closely with a wonderful community of pupils and their families, in this shared endeavour.

The well-equipped clinic, staffed by a full time Doctor and fully qualified nurses, attend to the physical welfare of our pupils.

Inclusion

In line with the UAE Inclusive Education Policy Framework 2018, the staff at Repton Dubai are committed to providing an inclusive education to all students. We strive to ensure that pupils with a

learning difference have a positive learning experience and are supported in their learning.

We treat pupils or prospective pupils with a learning difference, no less favourably than others. The school has the required support systems available to meet students' needs both at the admissions level and the classroom level. To this end we work collaboratively with management, departments, teachers, pastoral and medical teams, parents and pupils in supporting learning diversity. Repton School embraces the concept of inclusive education because it is the heart of effective education. We are an inclusive school that follows the newly-launched Dubai Inclusion Framework from KHDA.

Boarding

The two boarding houses [one boys and one girls] lie at the heart of the school and provide a residential opportunity for pupils at school, which is almost unique in the Middle East. Repton Dubai is able to offer residential boarding accommodation for those students and families who would benefit from the opportunities provided by either full term boarding or more flexible boarding options, such as weekly boarding. To provide the care and nurture that all young people need, each boarding house has a highly experienced housemaster or housemistress, and a resident house tutor; these staff are also supported by a residential matron, gap year boarding assistants, and ancillary support staff who include housekeepers, nurses and a UK qualified onsite doctor.



Our aim is to provide a caring, stimulating and happy environment where pupils grow into self-confident, active and successful young people.

Pupils are accommodated in rooms with en-suite bathrooms and personal study areas. High speed internet access is available in all of the study bedrooms and meals are cooked on site. In addition, boarders have access to world class facilities onsite as well as organised after school activities. Boarders are also encouraged to take full advantage of the opportunities available to them within Dubai such as golf, sailing, horse riding, go-karting, paintballing and overnight excursions, to name but a few!

GL Assessment Progress Results

Students in schools in Dubai are required to undertake GL Assessment Progress Tests in English, maths and science in the summer term, to assess their attainment in these core subjects. The Progress Tests results from these internationally recognised standardised tests at Repton Dubai are outstanding.

IGCSE Examination Results

The IGCSE examination results at Repton Dubai are outstanding. The progress that students make in their time here shows the hard work and dedication shown by students and staff.

94%, were successful in achieving 5 grades or more at A* – C.

- 29% of all grades achieved in 2018 were A*
- 51% of all grades achieved in 2018 were A* – A
- 76% of all grades achieved in 2018 were A* – B
- 91% of all grades achieved in 2018 were A* – C

Our results compare favourably with the best schools in the UK.

In Biology, Chemistry and Physics 80% of all grades are A* - A"

The graph below shows the upward trend in the percentage of grades achieved in each examination season over the last 4 years.

IB Examination Results

The growing numbers of students studying IB at Repton Dubai has led to an increased curriculum provision, with a full Diploma pathway and the highly regarded Careers Programme.

98% of our IBDP students have been awarded the IB Diploma, scoring an average of 34 points or more per student, against a typical global average of 30 points (2018 figures).

These excellent results ensured that all our students achieved the results required for admission into their university of choice, with a high percentage entering the prestigious Russel Group of Universities in the UK or Ivy League in the US. This year our graduating Reptonians are spreading across the world, with places gained at Oxford University, UC (University of California) Berkeley,

UCLA , St Andrews University, UCL (University College London), UAL (University of Arts London), Kings College (London), McGill University (Canada) and NYU (Abu Dhabi) amongst others.

This year we are also celebrating our first cohort of IB Careers Programme [IBCP] students and delighted that all students have successfully gained the Careers Programme qualification.

Digital Learning

The ability to use technology appropriately is a core skill all students need, in order to be successful in their later lives. At Repton Dubai all students have the opportunity to work with a wide variety of technology both as consumers and as creators.

Classrooms are equipped with interactive whiteboards and as we move towards becoming an Apple Distinguished School, the number of iPads available for students to use is increasing.

In computing, our recently refurbished Mac suite has ensured that students are using cutting edge technology to aid their work, while in Design Technology the use of 3D printing to produce projects has developed many new skills.

However, it is not just in the traditional subjects where the use of new technologies is encouraged; students in Drama regularly film and edit scenes using handheld devices and data is collected in Science and sent by Wi-Fi directly to a computer.

Innovation is both a process and a mindset. To support the UAE National Agenda and our students' development, at Repton we are developing the next generation of innovators. Teachers achieve this goal by acting as role models and being innovative in their teaching methods. Students are given the opportunity to innovate, during lessons and in regular competitions both in and outside of school. Nothing stands still at Repton; we are preparing our students for an ever changing world where the ability to innovate and think creatively will be paramount.

Sports

Sports form the backbone of the school ethos. Competitive sports allow students to develop their team-work skills, communication and sportsmanship. From Year 2 onwards the School offers three hours of physical education per week and actively promotes a healthy lifestyle throughout.



We provide a wide range of sporting opportunities and unrivalled indoor and outdoor facilities, and have a very successful track record competing with schools across Dubai.

Outdoor Education & Extra-Curricular Activities

We believe that learning and adventure is not restricted to the confines of the classroom or the formal curriculum. Outstanding schools offer a huge variety of sports and extra-curricular activities that are often student-led and designed to inspire and challenge in equal measure. Repton is determined to stay at the very forefront of this provision in sport, music, the performing and creative arts and in design, technology and innovation. Whether on top of a mountain in the French Alps, a community project in the jungles of Thailand, or facing a fast bowler on the cricket pitch,

all the activities and events we offer are designed to build confidence and character, resilience and grit.

Experience & Education Requirements for Teachers

- Bachelor's degree plus QTS and PGCE
- For specialist teachers, the bachelor's degree must be in a directly related field (eg, Physics teacher should have a science related bachelo'rs degree)
- For senior school positions teaching KS4 and above, IB experience is mandatory
- Generally we require a minimum of 2 years post qualification experience

Remuneration Package

- Accommodation (mandatory for those new to country due to visa restrictions), potential option of cash allowance in lieu of accommodation for those already resident in Dubai
