

In addition, all our schools are guided by national standards and directives mandated by the Qatar Ministry of Education and Higher Education.

Qatar is home to a remarkably diverse population, and this is reflected in our student body and the wealth of distinct cultural and learning identities and experiences that they represent. Through embracing the fast-growing multinational community of which we are a part, our schools offer learning opportunities that go beyond borders and continents. 
Exceeding excellence

Qatar Academy Al Khor (QAK) was established in 2008 to serve students from Al Khor and areas in the north of Qatar, extending our groundbreaking curriculum to a broader community. As an IB World School that predominantly educates native Qatari students and long-time residents, QAK is especially dedicated to developing local human capital.

QAK seamlessly blends its world-class international curriculum with Qatar's heritage and culture. In part, this is achieved by enabling students to thrive in a truly bilingual

environment that develops rich language skills in English and Arabic. Concurrently, since the student base is predominantly Qatari, QAK has made a conscious effort to recruit highly diverse international faculty to provide students with varied cultural perspectives. The school moved to a new, purpose-built and state-of-the-art campus in 2016, and is set to grow its intake rapidly over the coming years.

The school is currently located in the lively Education City campus and is scheduled to have a new, purpose-built facility ready for completion by 2021.



Located meters from the Doha Corniche, within the cultural hub of Doha, the QAM campus is inspired by traditional Qatari heritage and architecture.










Qatar Leadership Academy


the necessary behavioral and academic interventions to close learning gaps, enabling students to succeed in their post-secondary education, career, and community-related endeavors.

The school presently serves students aged 3 to 7 years, but will add a higher grade-level each successive year until it can serve students of all ages.




Qatar Academy for Science and Technology



Qatar Academy for Science and Technology (QAST) is a newly opened STEM high school dedicated to developing talented students who have a strong interest in the sciences. QAST is an ambitious project on its way to becoming one of the world's best STEM schools, setting examples through groundbreaking curricula and educational practice. The QAST program is designed to train students as inventive, technically minded problem solvers. The program offers three course curriculums in Computer Programming, Engineering, and Medical Sciences. The first two years focus on

establishing the knowledge and skills necessary for students to participate and thrive in collaborative problem-solving teams. The curriculum has been developed to equip students with the skills to address Qatar's Grand Challenges (Water, Food, and Energy Sustainability). As such, students actively collaborate with academic institutes, research centers, and industrial organizations all over the country.

Starting from Grade 9 in the fall of 2018, the school will continue to expand by one grade level each year.
