About Durston House

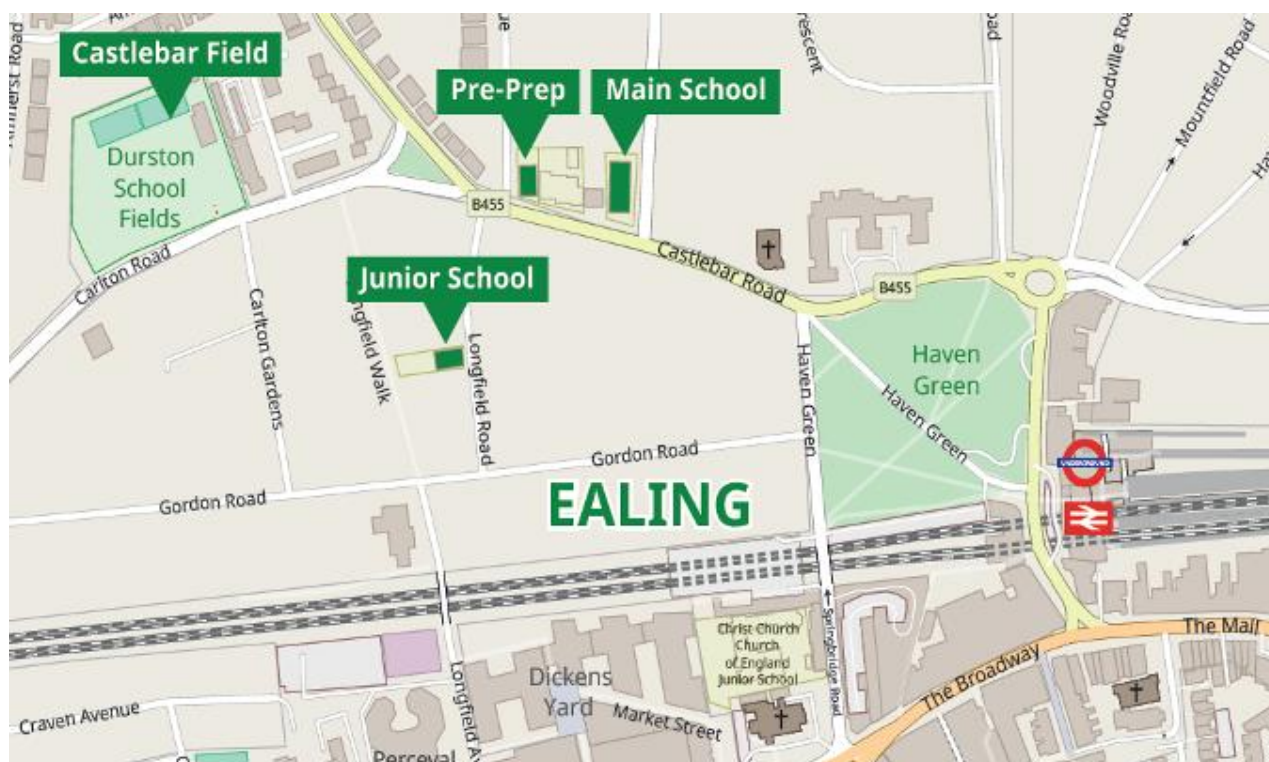
