In Year 7 and 8 students have one PSHEE lesson per week, whilst higher up the school students gain their PSHEE input on rotation with other subjects such as RE and Careers.

PSHEE is a vital and energetic subject at Northgate and we cover a broad spectrum of topics including really complex and personal subject matters such as diversity, relationships and crime. Within PSHEE, teachers help students tackle these multifaceted issues in a safe and accepting environment.
