Key Stage 5 – A Level Business (Edexcel) and Economics (Edexcel)

We have excellent results in both business and economics at A Level and have established the new specifications with success. We have a good range of resources to support teaching and learners. Students are passionate about the subjects with the majority progressing to higher education to study our subjects further.

<u>Key Stage 5 - BTEC Business Level 3 – Extended Certificate and Diploma</u>

BTEC Business is taken in combination with A Levels or another BTEC by our students. The students have high aspirations with the majority wanting to progress to university. Our results have been strong in all components and overall in recent years. We offer the Extended Certificate and Diploma as a single or double option.

KS4 GCSE Business (EDEXCEL) and GCSE Economics (AQA)

Business and Economics are taught separately at GCSE from year 10. The new specifications provide an excellent basis for progression to A Level and we had strong results in the first year. Many progress onto A Level study in the subject areas.

Extra-Curricular

The department have external speakers in each year and these will be closely linked to the courses to bring learning to life. We also engage with local business owners to provide feedback on BTEC units.

We currently offer Young Enterprise Company Programme. With companies winning several awards already this year and working well with local business advisors.

Tutor2u conferences are attended every year to give students extra support with exam technique and knowledge building. Students also attend other events during the year and regularly attend events out of school to develop their interest and understanding further including LSE talks and conferences.
