Core purpose			
The Swimming Instructor role will undertake duties in providing swimming instruction to children with a wide range of abilities and needs, and to ensure their health and safety.			
 To teach swimmers / individuals of all abilities and help them achieve the aims required of the Swim England standards and the National Curriculum, and to do so in a safe and encouraging manner To positively contribute to the school staff team To be a positive role model, creating a supportive environment to encourage swimmers to participate To maintain records of children's progress and achievement To develop and implement session plans in line with school policies and procedures to ensure high quality instruction To ensure all swimmers feel challenged during their weekly lesson and receive positive feedback To maintain high standards of behaviour so that children are engaged during their lessons, learn effectively and are safe in and around the swimming pool To support out of hours activities ie. swimming galas and competitions as required

 To set up and put away any equipment for lessons To undertake water chemistry tests as required To complete cleaning tasks to maintain site hygiene as required To administer first aid if required 			
 To implement the emergency action plan in the event of an emergency To follow and implement procedures from the Normal Operating Procedure To promote and safeguard the welfare of children, young and vulnerable people that you are responsible for, or come into contact with To liaise with parents and staff as appropriate To maintain confidentiality inside and outside the workplace 			
The employee may be called upon to perform other duties that the Head Teacher considers reasonable, that are commensurate with the grading and designation of the post.
