

Senior Technician - Design Technology Terms & Conditions

Salary

The salary for the post will be Grade 8. The actual annual salary range is £16,638 to £18,476. This is equivalent to £12.60 to £13.99 per hour. Starting salary will be dependent upon qualifications and previous, directly comparable experience.

There will be an entitlement to paid leave, based on length of service (starting at a minimum 5.89 weeks per year). Leave must be taken during school holidays.

Hours

The hours are 30 hours per week, to be worked over 4 days, term time only.

This is initially a 1 Year fixed term contract from 1st September 2019 – 31st August 2020 with the potential to be extended for a second year.

Terms and Conditions

The Thame Partnership Academy Trust employs support staff working at Lord Williams's School on the conditions of service contained in the National Joint Council for Local Government Services National Agreement on Pay and Conditions of Service (Green Book), the provisions of which allow for a 26 week probationary period for new employees.
