

Science Provision at Xaverian College

Our science provision is currently delivered in a dedicated Science Block, the Xavier Building on the main College Campus. From September 2025, a newly built state of the art science building will be ready for teaching. There are currently over 1000 students in the Faculty.

Xaverian College offers A level courses in Biology, Chemistry, Maths, Further Maths, Statistics and Physics. It also offers GCSE Maths and BTEC Applied Science. Additionally, we also provide Foundation Year Programmes in Biosciences, Dentistry, Medicine and Pharmacy for students from the University of Manchester. From September 2025, we will also be offering a suite of AAQs in Science.

Our science provision is currently delivered by a team of 27 teachers and 3 laboratory technicians.

The Xavier Building is well resourced and equipped with:

- Two dedicated laboratories for each curriculum area in Science
- High standard laboratory equipment
- Resource Rooms equipped with PC's with internet and intranet access
- A Lecture Theatre and two large 'dry laboratories' in the Faculty area
- A number of well-equipped classrooms and two large seminar rooms
- Dedicated University student Common Room and IT Room
