The Humanities Department

The department currently consists of 5 full time and 2 part-time members. Subjects taught within the department are:- History, Geography and Culture and issues at Key Stage 3. At key Stage 4 the GCSE options in Humanities are Business Studies, Geography, History, Philosophy and RE. In Year 7 a common Humanities course, made up of distinct History, Geography and R.E. modules, is taught to each year 7 class by one teacher for 5 periods per week. The successful candidate will be expected to teach at least one Year 7 Humanities group. After Year 7, all Humanities subjects are taught separately.

The Humanities Department takes pride in maintaining a record of success at GCSE and a reputation for setting and maintaining high academic standards at all levels. In a recent department review our work and teaching was described as Good.
