1.0 Main Duties

1.1 To meet the core standards for teachers as outlined in the School Teachers' Pay and Conditions Document (STPCD).

And To:

- 1.2 Assist in the development of appropriate schemes of work and resources;
- 1.3 contribute to the school/department's development plan and its implementation;
- 1.4 contribute to the ethos of the whole school and uphold it on an every-day basis;
- 1.5 support the school motto Aspire, Believe, Achieve;
- 1.6 attend staff development training sessions as agreed with your line manager and in line with school policy;
- 1.7 engage actively in the Performance Management Review process;
- 1.8 ensure the effective/efficient deployment of classroom support;
- 1.9 implement the School assessment and marking policy meeting all deadlines;
- 1.10 maintain appropriate records and to provide relevant accurate and up-to-date information;
- 1.11 track student progress and use information to inform teaching and learning;
- 1.12 communicate effectively and regularly with parents;
- 1.13 follow agreed procedures in relation to the use of IT equipment and policy on computer security;
- 1.14 take part in activities such as Open Evenings, Carol Concerts and Parents' Evenings etc;
- 1.15 co-operate with other staff to ensure a sharing and effective usage of resources to the benefit of the School, department and the students;
- 1.16 apply the Behaviour Management policy consistently.

2.0 Pastoral System:

- 2.1 be a Form Tutor to an assigned group of students and follow the job outline as illustrated in the staff handbook:
- 2.2 register students, accompany them to assemblies, encourage their full attendance at all lessons and their participation in other aspects of School life;
- 2.3 monitor the academic progress of each child in the tutor group;

- evaluate and monitor the progress of students and keep up-to-date student records;
- 2.5 communicate as appropriate with the parents of students
- 2.6 contribute to PSE programme and ensure lessons are planned to the same stand as those of your main subject.
