

# **GERMAN AT ISZN**

All pupils from the age of 5 upwards receive four lessons per week of formal German language teaching. Pupils are grouped according to their language proficiency, so that regardless of whether the child is a native speaker or an absolute beginner, they will receive instruction appropriate to their need. The development of the curriculum until Grade 8 is based around progress through the Common European Framework for Languages. From Grade 9 onwards students work towards a curriculum suited to their ability and future needs, this might be iGCSE/A-Level German for students intending to apply to UK or North America universities, or Goethe Institut exams for those wishing to remain in Switzerland.



## **WORKING FOR ISZN**

At ISZN we recognise that teachers are our most valuable resource and, consequently, we look after them accordingly. Not only do we take our commitment to professional development seriously, we also understand the importance of teacher wellbeing. Great schools thrive on discretional effort, and that can only be built in a culture of mutual care and trust. 
# **WORKING IN SWITZERLAND**

While the country is expensive, our pay reflects that fact and teachers enjoy a good standard of living.
