About Geneva English School

Geneva English School (GES) is an international, British curriculum, not-for-profit school, based just outside central Geneva. Since its foundation in 1961, the school has maintained its very strong sense of community and we are proud of the high-quality, holistic and innovative education we provide to our pupils.

GES is a member of <u>COBIS</u>, <u>IAPS</u>, <u>AGBIS</u>, <u>SGIS</u> and <u>AGEP</u> and was rated "excellent" in every area of our provision by the <u>Independent Schools Inspectorate</u> – the highest possible rating. Our broad and enriching educational programme has its foundations in the UK national curriculum, but is continuously enhanced and adapted so it is relevant and applicable to our international community and ensures we take advantage of our beautiful, local surroundings.

The nursery and primary school are housed in an elegant, mid-nineteenth century building in Genthod by Lake Geneva. The campus includes five acres of outside space, an indoor gym, library, 22 classrooms and spacious, specialist classrooms for art, music and drama.

JOB PURPOSE

To teach mathematics from KS3 through to KS5 and at A level.

RESPONSIBLE TO

The Head of Mathematics and Assistant Headteachers.

TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work closely with the Head of Mathematics, planning for continuity and progression throughout the School
- Work with the Assistant Headteachers of KS3 or KS4 and KS5 to be a tutor within the school's pastoral system.

KEY TASKS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Teach the lessons assigned to you, planning appropriately to meet the needs of all pupils, making effective use of resources, and securing the best possible standards of learning and achievement.
- Maintain good order and discipline amongst pupils, in accordance with the School's behaviour policy, and have due regard for their welfare, health and safety.
- Maintain a productive learning environment by employing good classroom techniques, resources and management skills.
- Follow guidelines for assessment as set out by the School and keep appropriate records.
- Establish professional and effective communication with parents, reporting to them formally and informally on the development, progress and attainment of pupils.
- Liaise with the Deputy Head and with Tutors about any pupils with specific learning needs or giving rise to learning or pastoral concerns.
- Contribute to the creation of a stimulating learning environment around the School.
- Show an active commitment to the wider life of the School, including extra-curricular activities and events.
- Show commitment to your own professional development and take an active interest in educational debate and development.
- Carry out administrative and supervisory duties efficiently and conscientiously.
- Supervise and, so far as is practicable, teach any pupils who are assigned to you by the teacher in charge of cover arrangements.
- Undertake such other tasks as may be reasonably assigned by the Deputy Head or Head from time to time.
- Act in accordance with the policies of the School and in particular with the principles laid down in the Staff Handbook, Staff Code of Conduct, ICT Acceptable Use Policy and Safeguarding & Child Protection Policy.

- Experience of teaching Mathematics to pupils from 11 to 18 years old in a UK curriculum setting (State, Private or International).
- Track record of successful GCSE and A level results adding value and stretching the most able.
- Ability to teach mixed ability classes getting the best results for all students
- Knowledge of the English National Curriculum.
- Proficiency in spoken and written English.
- The desire to work in a highly collaborative department in which all teachers use the same mathematical models to create a consistent experience for pupils
- The ability to develop online teaching resources tailored to the GES maths curriculum
- A proactive approach to professional development, striving to improve your own practice
- A commitment to helping students to develop a broad range of skills and attributes
- The ability to communicate effectively with pupils, colleagues and parents
- Flexibility, a sense of humour, and a willingness to contribute to all aspects of school life, including trips, projects, special events and extracurricular clubs
- Qualified teacher status

- EU/Swiss passport or valid work permit for Switzerland.

SALARY AND BENEFITS

The salary for this role will be between 80'000 CHF and 96'000 CHF, depending on experience. In addition, 400 CHF will be paid per month as a contribution to your medical health premium if you are offered a permanent contract. Staff children can attend the school at ¹/₃ of the tuition fee and our After School Care on Primary will be free of charge.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications should be made through our TES school portal in English and consist of a covering letter (no more than two sides of A4) outlining how you meet the personal specification and a completed online application form. The covering letter can be uploaded as part of your application on the TES. **Please do not send a CV**, as they are not accepted, nor apply outside of the TES platform.

In your application letter you should ensure that you outline your impact and successes, and how you meet the job description and person specification. Due to the large number of applications we
