Job Purpose and outline:

• To deliver information and research skills for the school

- To work closely with departments, teachers and pupils in the support of the curriculum and pupils/staff. To assist with the management of the Library, special collections and the Archive
- Responsibility for the day to day management of the Library Assistants
- To undertake any other duties that ensure the smooth running of the Haileybury Information and Knowledge Service

Principal Duties:

- The post participates in the provision and support of research and information skills
- The post acts as a liaison between the Information and Knowledge Service's resources and pupils, teaching staff, and academic departments
- The day to day responsibility for the management of the Library Assistants
- The post will support the Director of Learning and Research in meeting the strategic plan for Learning and Research through the Haileybury Information and Knowledge Service

The post-holder will:

- Support the Director of Learning and Research to develop an overview and strategy for the Haileybury Information and Knowledge Service each year. Maintain and develop the resources in the Library and elsewhere in response to the needs of pupils and teachers
- Provide information and research skills for pupils and teachers in the form of lessons and one to one support
- Develop the Library and Archive catalogue and learning platform
- Provide support in academic departments and pupils
- Develop resources to support academic departments and the International Baccalaureate diploma
- Run appropriate societies and groups
- Develop the use and profile of special collections and Archive
- Support the development and maintenance of the collections
- Maintain excellent communications with the Information and Knowledge Service team to ensure circulation and dissemination of information

It should be noted that this job description identifies the current principal duties of the post; it does not detail every task to be undertaken. The post-holder will be required to undertake any duties as required by the Line Manager, which fall within their capabilities or the requirements of the School.
