

The Maths Department

The Maths Department comprises an extremely dedicated, dynamic forward-looking staff team. A leadership structure of two Director posts, in place since September 2014, has secured strong leadership and driven up standards.

As well as the Director posts, the department has within it two further TLR posts linked to key areas to maximise achievement and to provide professional development opportunities and progression for staff.

Results over the last three years have been consistently around 65% A* to C. 'A' Level results have improved significantly. In 2016 54% of students secured A* to B grades at A2 and 77% A* to C grades.

The School has a three year Key Stage 4 with students at GCSE undertaking a linear Edexcel course. We have a rapidly increasing number of A Level students year on year and both Maths and Further Maths are taught as part of our Post 16 curriculum offer.

The Department is extremely well resourced. In September 2016 the new building was completed which houses nine new Maths classrooms, a large Maths office and work area, as well as Expressive Arts facilities, a dining hall and sports hall. All classrooms have interactive whiteboard and tablet facilities with further investment in mobile technology coming soon to support learning in Maths.

The successful candidate will be expected to work with colleagues to continue to move the department forward. We are looking for someone who can inject energy and inspire students to develop a love of Maths, build their confidence and prepare students for the challenges of the new curriculum.
