

MATHS

The department comprises five full-time and one part-time member of staff and is situated in six classrooms, with all rooms benefiting from projectors, visualisers and interactive whiteboards. Maths is a popular subject in the school, and results have followed an upward trend in recent years.

The department follows the AQA specification at GCSE (code 8300). At Key Stage 3 and 4 we follow the Redhill Trust 5 year scheme of learning which is fluid and encourages the use of a wide and varied range of resources and teaching materials to help support pupil progress, as well as to enable enquiry-based learning.

The department works closely with the Trust Director for Maths, allowing for consistent assessments and interventions across Trust schools, as well as high quality CPD and shared resources.

Students have 3 hours of Maths lessons per week in years 7 and 8 that increases to 4 hours per week and in years 9, 10 and 11. Those students requiring extra support take part in small-group intervention sessions or attend our increasingly popular maths clinic.

Maths forms a key component in any school and hence the successful candidate will play a crucial part in continuing to build on the successes of both the Maths department and the school as a whole.
