Key Responsibilities:

- To advise teachers on their experimental work.
- To ensure that all equipment is kept in good working order, liaising with other departments (e.g. IT) as necessary.

Other duties:

- To drive school vehicles (including a minibus) as required for the fulfilment of other duties.
- To handle data in a way that is compliant with the Data Protection Policy.
- To undertake other activities of a similar level and scope, as directed by the school's management team and science teachers.
