Modern Foreign Languages is located on the upper floor of the Humanities Block at Wootton Upper School. There are four classrooms and a break out area along with a departmental resource area.

In Year 9 students continue studying French as well as starting a second language either German or Spanish.

Students are taught both languages in ability groups. Each language is allocated two hours per week. At French GCSE the course and syllabus started is AQA4655 and at A Level the course and syllabus is Edexcel9FR01. Last year 89% of students passed French at GCSE at A*- C and results at A Level were 100% pass rate.

The Department has a General Assistant who is also a French Language Assistant. The team of Modern Linguists consists of six and three Language Assistants, one of who is also the Department's General Assistant.

Modern Foreign Languages have a high profile at the school. The person appointed to this temporary post will be well supported and will enjoy teaching some delightful students.
