Job Description

To provide academic support, assessment, and pastoral care to a student with visual impairment. To carry out duties in the most cost-effective and efficient way. You will follow all legislation, as well as our own policies and procedures, relating to working with children, safeguarding, and Health and Safety. You will satisfy all criteria and checks relating to suitability to work in a school environment.

Main Duties:

- To academically and pastorally support a student with visual impairment both in the classroom and during study periods in the Learning Hub.
- Support the social and emotional development of students, reporting any issues when required.
- Use School Platforms to keep records of observations and interventions.
- Promote positive behaviour in all lessons.
- Help with ensuring student progress as part of adaptive teaching.
- Provide regular feedback on student's progress.
- Familiarisation with and adherence to School Policies.
- Prepare for in-class support, by liaising with the subject teacher and gaining planning in advance.
- Carry out administrative duties, including entering data on School Platforms.
- Provide support outside of your normal classes, such as helping during exams, covering TA absences or going on school trips.
