

FELSTED SCHOOL JOB DESCRIPTION

Electrical Engineering Apprentice

The Role

Accountable to: Electrical Supervisor and Mechanical & Electrical Manager

To carry out all types of electrical work (and other related trades) to maintain, improve and enhance school buildings, whilst working in conjunction with other Works Department tradesmen. To carry out any tasks within the job holders skill and ability.

Role Responsibilities

- To study and complete the Electrotechnical Apprenticeship
- To assist in undertaking daily maintenance, fault finding and repair to the electrical installations within School properties.
- To assist in undertaking minor works in respect of renewing, replacing and repairing the electrical installations within the School.
- To assist in undertaking new electrical installations as directed including works to fire alarms, emergency lighting, low voltage power, mains distribution and sub mains.
- To assist in undertaking testing of portable appliances within the School.
- To assist in undertaking any reasonable task at the request of the Works Manager/Estates Manager.
- Attending College/training as necessary in order to complete the prescribed apprenticeship course.

Skills, Knowledge and Experience Essential:

- 1. Keen interest in electrical work
- 2. Good level of education, A*-C grade GCSE's in Maths and English or hold equivalent qualifications
- 3. Positive 'can-do' attitude towards customer service
- 4. Should be confident in team work and working with people and building effective professional working relationships

- 6. Should be familiar with common IT software and be proficient in the use of Word and Excel

- 7. Previous electrical experience and/or already enrolled on a recognised Electrical Apprenticeship Programme
